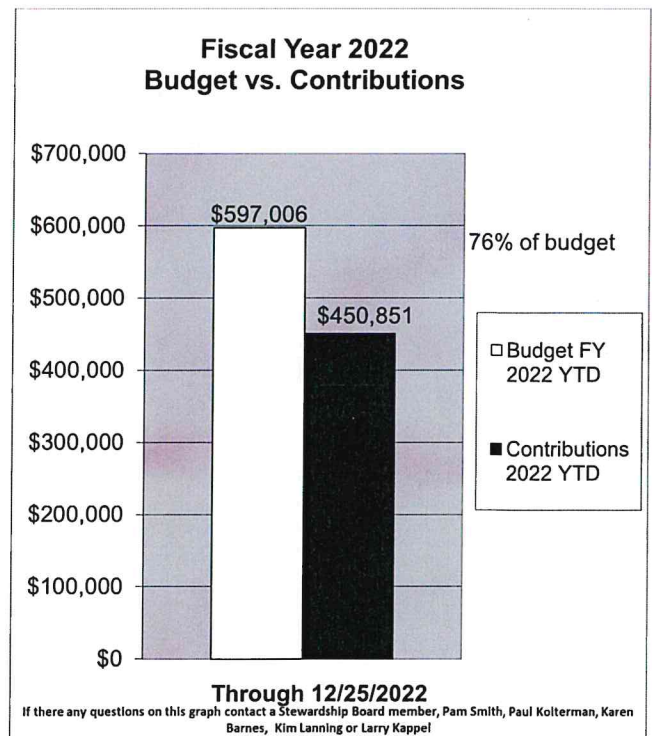
Stewardship

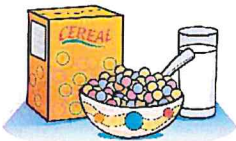
Women's Guild

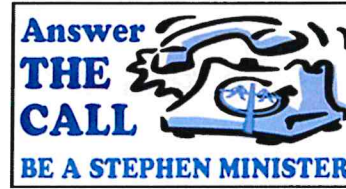

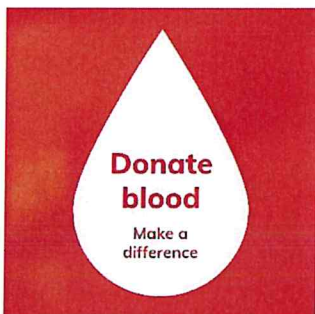
Leaping into Preschool
