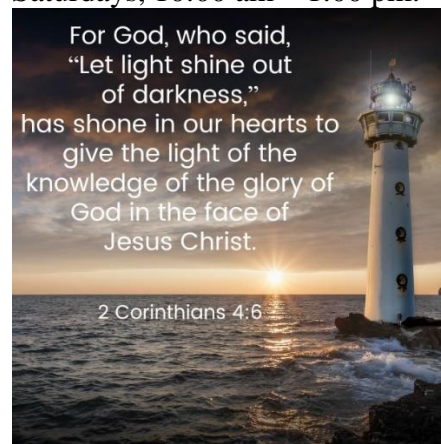

Growing in Faith Through Stewardship

Exodus 25:1 – “The Lord said to Moses, “Speak to the people of Israel, that they take for Me a contribution. From every man whose heart moves Him you shall receive the contribution for Me.””

In the verse quoted above, God established the concept of tithing but was careful to clearly state “From every man whose heart moves Him....”. This phrase makes it clear that God is primarily interested in the heart (motive) of the giver, not necessarily the amount of the gift, after all God does not need anything from His people, after all, everything already belongs to Him. But He recognizes the need of the people to love Him above all other distractions (gods) and gladly demonstrate that love through willfully contributing their first fruits to advance the Gospel through the bride of Christ, His Holy Church. Elsewhere in the Bible God states, “where a man’s treasure is also resides his heart”. Recognizing this is key for all of us at Faith to grow our faith through responsible stewardship.

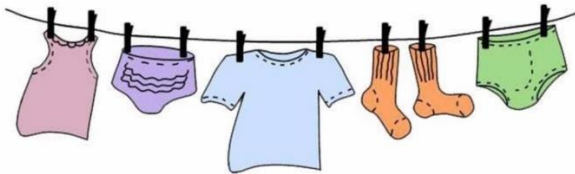

Please consider continuing your generosity by bringing in canned fruits or canned vegetables for the month of February.



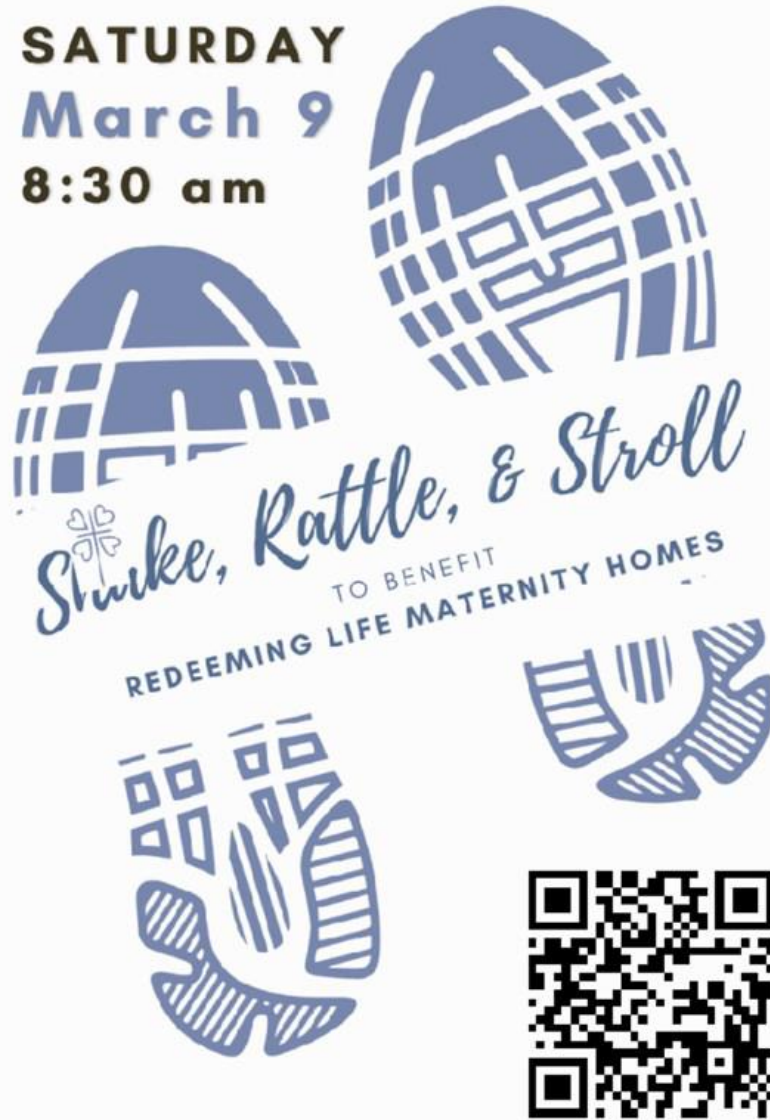
