Lorelei L. finished 4<sup>th</sup> in the shot put while throwing a personal record. Kenidee L. also finished 7<sup>th</sup> in the shot put. Anayeli S. finished in 7<sup>th</sup> in the 800 meters. The relay team of Ella Z., Jady A., Lorelei L., and Joely S. rounded out the scoring for the Crusdaers by finishing 6<sup>th</sup> in the 4x100 meter relay.

On the boy's side, Eric C. continued his great season with a 1st place finish in the 3000 meters and breaking the school record. In the 100 meters, Ella Z., Jady A., Hollis J., and Lucian F. all had personal best. Finally, in the 200 meters, Kenidee L., Jacob F., and Landon L. all achieved a personal best.

The Crusaders will compete in one more meet on March 31<sup>st</sup> when they travel to Ocala for the Central Florida Lutheran League Track Meet.


