Operation Christmas Child

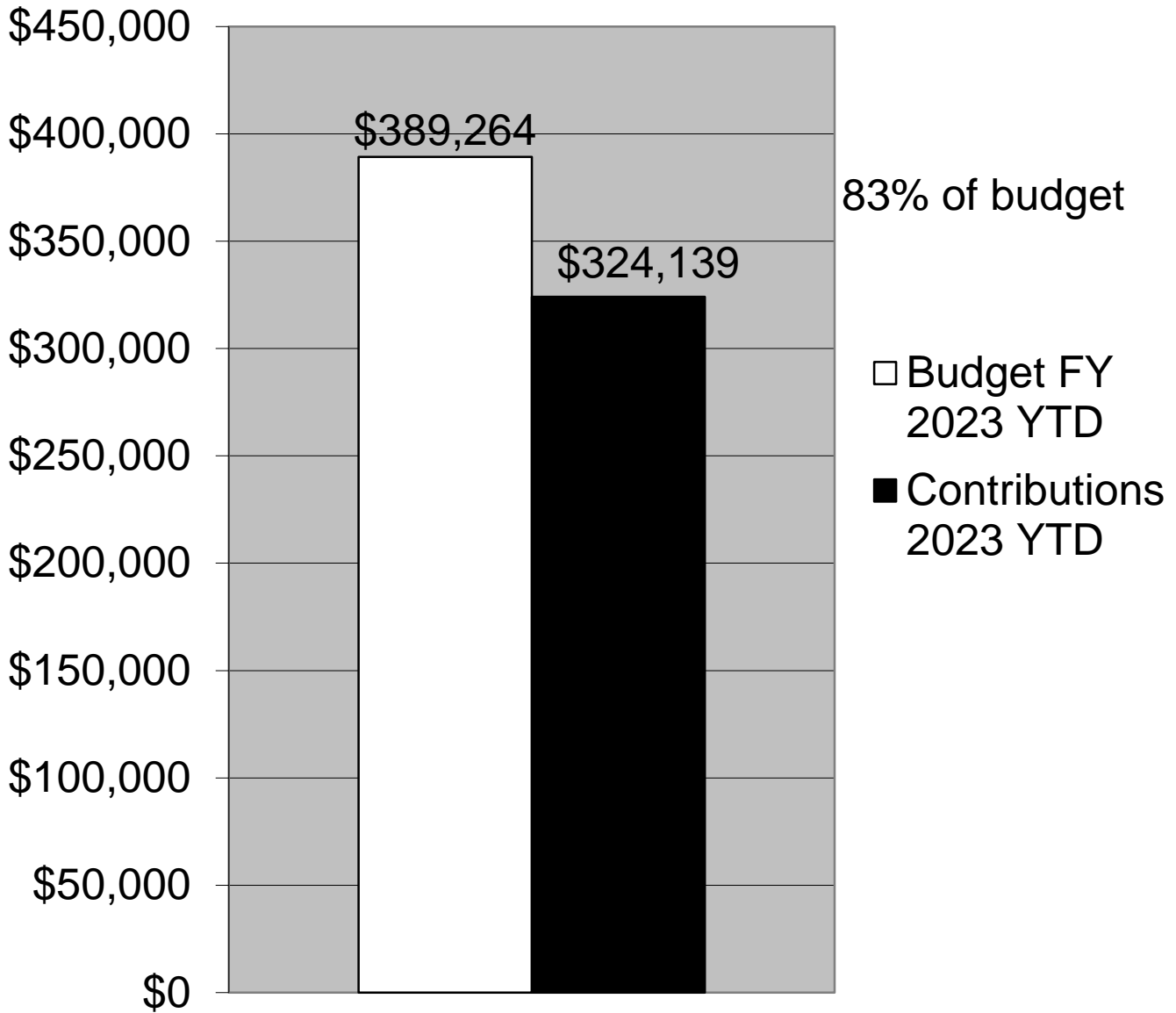
Declare His glory among the nations! Psalm 96:3

Operation Christmas Child is a longstanding outreach sponsored by Samaritan's Purse. This outreach has provided millions of boys and girls around the world, aged 2-14 years, with an introduction to their Savior Jesus via a gift- and Bible storybook-filled shoebox. Children receive these gifts and take the storybook home to share with family members and friends. This is a fun activity for everyone and helps children and families who do not know about Jesus.

If you are interested in filling a shoebox for a child, official boxes and information about how to fill one will be available at church services on **September 30 and October 1** (you are also welcome to use your own shoebox). Return the filled box to Church or to the Faith Lutheran Church office **by Sunday November 12**. Don't forget to include a check for \$10 written to ***Samaritan's Purse*** for transportation costs. Filled shoe boxes will be delivered to a Christmas Child collection site by Women's Guild members during the Operation Christmas Child Shoebox Collection Week November 13-20. Print your label and attach it to your shoebox. Be sure not to tape over the QR code when you attach the label to your box. You can then use your email address or label code to track your shoebox gift to the country it was delivered [\(this information is usually available in late December or January\)](#).
