SCRIP FUNDRAISER AND CONTEST

Are you planning on giving gift cards this Christmas?

Buy your gift cards here at Faith Lutheran School and the school will receive a commission.

The Scrip Fundraiser Contest begins this week. If Faith has 200 gift cards sold by December 11, 2023 every class will receive a prize. All profits will be used to buy books for the school library. Happy shopping!

We have already sold 28 cards toward our goal.

What is Scrip?

Scrip is a program that purchases gift cards and the school purchases these gift cards from Scrip at a discount. We offer these gift cards to parents at face value. You receive dollar for dollar the valve of cash for these items. Example: You pay \$50 for a Target card and you will purchase \$50 at Target. The school will receive a percentage for the card from Scrip.

Remember gift cards are great for grandparents, aunts and uncles, nieces and nephews, teachers, office staff, support staff, etc.

- Scrip orders and payments need to be into the school office on Mondays by 12:00 pm.
 - Cards will be available for pick up in the school office by Friday of that week.

The school office does have a few cards that are available for purchase at any time.

All Christmas orders need to be turned in by Monday, December 11th to guarantee delivery before Christmas Break.
