Letter from the Pastor

October, 2023

Dear Friends in Christ,

Technology, everything is being updated and technology is the word of the day. Maybe you have noticed that we have made some sophisticated changes on the technology level. If you have, I am sure you can appreciate how we are reckoning the ministry to the 21st

century, practically speaking.

Theologically we are still a 500-year-old doctrine, and 5,000-7,000 year old doctrine if you want to get technical. But practically we are connected our ministry to the next generation of members that are already taking a key leadership role on how we will reach the lost and proclaim the gospel more

effectively through technology.

Luther recognized this when he took advantage of the printing press to send the message of the gospel in print to a mass audience which set the scene for the Reformation we celebrate to this day. So, we have a rich tradition of using technology

October is Church Worker Appreciation Month!

Dear Friends in Christ,

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ (Phil. 1:2).

In addition to the Office of the Holy Ministry (pastors), the LCMS has seven other full-time church work vocations. One of these vocations is the Lutheran school teacher. There are currently over 16,000 schoolteachers in the LCMS. Our rostered LCMS school teachers earned their bachelor's degree and are certified by one of our six Concordia universities. Our Lutheran school teachers are faithful to God's Word and have a passion for teaching. Our teachers are dedicated to their vocation. In addition to teaching, many of them lead extracurricular activities and are active in the life of the congregation. The LCMS church work recruitment initiative, Set Apart to Serve (SAS), has designated October as Church Worker Appreciation Month. While we encourage you to recognize all your church workers, SAS is especially focusing on our Lutheran school teachers this year.

Our Lutheran school teachers have a heart and passion to teach God's Word to our children, that they may know and believe in Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of sin and eternal salvation. Nothing compares to our children being immersed in God's Word. Our Lutheran school teachers share this Word every day through Bible lessons, chapel, discipline, personal care of each child and the integration of the faith in every subject. Our teachers work long hours, often lead extracurricular activities and are involved in many aspects of congregational life.

Many of the things mentioned above are true for all our church workers. Therefore, SAS encourages our congregations and schools to recognize their church workers during the month of October. Here are some ideas to consider:

- Do a random act of kindness for your church workers deliver a cup of coffee, give them their favorite chocolate bar, wash their car, send them flowers, give them a bag of fruit or produce, give them a jar of homemade canned goods.
- Talk about the blessings of each of your church workers at home with your spouse, children or grandchildren. Then, pray for them.

4-6 Volleyball Takes Another to Set to Extra Points!


